Call for Entries

The Department of Fire Protection Engineering calls for currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate students, and high school students participating in the Design Challenge, to submit an original digital image that could be used as the logo of the 2018-2019 Design Challenge.

The Fire Protection Engineering Design Challenge is a semester-long high school outreach program, over the course of which participating students learn basic fire protection engineering concepts and work in teams to design a small-scale structure with creative detection and suppression systems designs.

The winning artist will have their digital image featured on the official Design Challenge T-shirt to be distributed to high school teachers and students participating in the Design Challenge this academic year. The winning artist's work will also be featured on the Department's website, along with their name and institutional affiliation. If the winning artist is not a high school student, they will also be gifted a T-shirt.

Contest Submission Guidelines

Entrants may submit one original digital image to fonuma@umd.edu by 11:59pm EST on Wednesday, March 13, 2019. The Department of Fire Protection Engineering reserves the right to not select any digital image.

Parameters for Digital Image

- Digital image should depict some element of fire (or fire protection engineering), team work, and fun, however the entrant chooses to interpret these concerns.
- The title of the competition, "Fire Protection Engineering Design Challenge," should also be incorporated into the design.
- Submitted digital image must be original work, designed by the entrant.
- Digital image may be in color or black and white.
- Design may be oriented as portrait or landscape, but should be no larger than 10''x12''.
- Embed or include any images or fonts used, and in the case of .cdr files, please convert text to curves.
- Prior to submission, file must be saved as .pdf, .ai, .eps, .cdr, .doc, .ppt, .pub, .jpg, .tif, .pcx, .gif, .png, or .bmp.

Selection

Select members of the Department's faculty and staff will review submissions. Entrants will remain anonymous throughout the competition. If a selection is made, the winner will be notified by Friday, March 29, 2019.
