



## Visiting Assistant Professor of Engineering

Washington and Lee University seeks a Visiting Assistant Professor of Engineering beginning fall 2020. This is a three-year, full-time position, authorized due to sustained enrollment demand. Applicants should have demonstrated interest in teaching and mentoring undergraduates and ability to teach courses across an engineering curriculum, including engineering mechanics or circuits and topical courses at the upper level. Ph.D. in a field of engineering, or an M.S. or M.E. with relevant industry experience is required. Strong candidates nearing completion of the Ph.D. may also be considered for appointment at the rank of visiting instructor. The person we hire will teach six courses in the 2020-21 academic year and will contribute to discussions on expanding the curriculum to include coursework at the intersection of engineering design and society. The Department of Physics and Engineering prizes the teacher-scholar model and is dedicated to engaging with our exceptional students in small classes. We actively promote a dynamic and inclusive environment that allows students and employees of multiple backgrounds, cultures, and perspectives to learn, work, and thrive together.
