As a Wildfire intern, you'll get experience in supporting IBHS's research including, but not limited to:

- Design and execute experiments at the IBHS research center to examine the vulnerability of hot tubs or similar connective fuels to wildfire ignitions and their potential role in suburban conflagration.
- Lead the execution of a set of experiments aimed at understanding the impact of connective fuels within Zone 0 and Zone 1 of structures experiencing characteristic wildfire exposures.
- Support the many wildfire test initiatives that IBHS will executing next year
- Support the ADU burn testing that investigates the key drivers of structure-to-structure fire spread through full scale wind driven fire experiments.
- Involvement in all facets of experimental fire testing including physical setup, instrumentation, execution, clean up, and data collection, curating of data and data analysis
